Are you legally required to have a leasing license?

Who needs to be licensed? According to the Illinois Real Estate License Act of 2000, nearly everyone engaged in leasing of residential property must obtain a leasing license. A few exemptions do exist, but for those who need to satisfy these requirements, CAA is partnering with Technical Training Consultants to offer a pre-licensing course.
